- Drupal.org project listing (+/- 20,000)
  - Filter by Drupal version and full projects
  - Browse by category
  - Search by name
  - Example: “Module filter”
- drupalmodules.com
- Podcasts
  - drupaleasy.com
  - modulesunraveled.com
- The Weekly Drop (theweeklydrop.com)

# Choosing modules

## Drupal.org project page

- Development status
- Versions
- Date of most recent version
- Reported installs & usage statistics
- Issue queue

# Evaluating modules

- Download untried new modules one at a time
- Read the documentation (Advanced Help)
- Look at all the configuration options
- Test it out.

Not for you?

- Disable it
- Uninstall it
- Delete the folder.



# Managing modules

Add a contrib folder: `sites/all/modules/contrib`.  
If you ever develop your own module, you'll put it in `sites/all/modules/custom`.

`drush dl [modulename]`, `drush en [modulename]`

OR

1. Download the compressed file, unpack it, put the module folder in the contrib folder.
2. Delete the compressed file.
3. Enable the module and any submodules you might need.

# Administration

- Backup and Migrate\* (backup\_migrate)
- Admin Menu\* (admin\_menu) - Note: disable the core toolbar.
- Libraries API\* (libraries)
- Module Filter (module\_filter)
- Permissions Filter (filter\_perms)
- Advanced Help (advanced\_help)

# Development

- Chaos Tools\* (ctools) - Required for Views and other modules.
- Devel\* (especially for generate & switch user block)
- **\*\*\*drush\*\*\*** (not a module, but a command line utility must-have)

# Content-related

- Field support\*
  - Link
  - Email
  - Date
  - Number
  - Phone
  - Entity
  - Entity Reference (entityreference)
  - Options Element (options\_element)
  - Select or other (select\_or\_other)
  - Media
  - Address (addressfield)

# Content-related

- Automatic Nodetitles\* (auto\_nodetitle) - with token, allows using tokens to create other node titles
- Pathauto\*
- Global Redirect\* (globalredirect)
- Add Another (addanother) - Allows user to create one node after another, similar to node\_clone
- Page Title (page\_title)
- Webform\*

# Content creation

- WYSIWYG\* - Uses CKEditor library
- CKEditor\* (not the CKEditor module; put in sites/all/libraries)
- CKEditor Link
- Linkit

# Content display

- Views\*
  - Views Bulk Operations (views\_bulk\_operations)
  - Draggable Views (draggableviews)
- Menu Block (menu\_block)
- Context - rule-driven display
- Token\* - displays contents of individual fields in various places other than the field itself

# Other miscellany

- Rules (not always needed, but useful)
- Invisimail (encodes email addresses)
- Honeypot - spam prevention
- Mollom - spam prevention
- SEO Checklist (seo\_checklist)
- Security Review (security\_review)
